



2017 Geauga Youth Employment Program (GYEP) 16 - 24 Year Old Youth eligibility requirements and what to bring to the orientation meeting:

Eligibility Requirements:

- 16 - 24 years of age
- And: Resident of Geauga County
- And: Income Eligible (at or below 200% of the Federal Poverty Level Guidelines)
Or: Documented WIOA Barrier (to be determined)
(Youth 14-17 is the minor in the household)
- Or: A Youth age 16 - 18 in Foster Care or in temporary or permanent custody of a Children's Services Agency are also eligible

Register first. Next, you **MUST bring the following documents with you to the orientation:**

- Completed 3002 Eligibility Application (After the youth has registered for orientation, an application will be mailed to the Youth's registered address)
- Birth Certificate
- Photo I.D. (non-expired)
- Social Security Card
- Copy of most recent Report Card
- Proof of Household Income from previous 30 day period or Barrier Documentation
- Copy of a Voided Check and/or Savings Account Statement is needed for Direct Deposit (if available)
- If applicable: Selective Service Registration
